

# 2021-2022 projects funded by women of good samaritan

**Sensory integration vests** Weighted vests are used to restore balance and stability in patients suffering neurological disorders.

**Companions for older adults** Older adults with dementia receive stuffed animals during an acute hospitalization to decrease their agitation and delirium.

**Ceiling lifts** Equipment to safely turn post-operative patients in their beds.

**Staff wellness resources** The Surgical Specialties unit will receive nursing resources addressing burnout and compassion fatigue.

**Donate Life flags for honor walk** Donate Life flags are placed on organ donors to honor them during transport from the Intensive Care Unit to the operating room.

**Neoprobe for breast cancer care** Machine for node biopsy procedures, providing more accuracy and allowing surgeons to remove less node tissue with better results for the patient.

**Technology accessibility bundle** Tools such as phone holders and mouth-controlled computer mice to help with dexterity and mobility issues.

**Heart failure patient supplies** Items to help low-income patients manage their health, such as scales, blood pressure monitors and vital signs logbooks.

**The Wisdom of Trauma** This documentary film by world-renowned trauma expert Dr. Gabor Mate will be screened for staff, followed by coaching to enhance the culture of care.

**Cornell Clinic support groups** The clinic will provide domestic violence resources and educational materials, trauma recovery and empowerment books to benefit approximately 4,000 patients.

**Panda infant warmers** Equipment allowing staff to start newborn resuscitation in patient rooms and continue it during transfer to the nursery for care.
